

The Thursday Before the Crucifixion (Evening)

(John 13) {16} "Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. {17} "If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them. {18} "I do not speak concerning all of you. I know whom I have chosen; but that the Scripture may be fulfilled, 'He who eats bread with Me has lifted up his heel against Me.' {19} "Now I tell you before it comes, that when it does come to pass, you may believe that I am He. {20} "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who receives whomever I send receives Me; and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me." {21} When Jesus had said these things, He was troubled in spirit, and testified and said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, one of you (Mark 14:18 eats with Me; Luke 22:21 on the table) will betray Me." {22} Then the disciples looked at one another, perplexed about whom He spoke.

(Matthew 26) {22} And they were exceedingly sorrowful, and each of them began to say to Him, "Lord, is it I?" {23} He answered and said, "He who dipped his hand with Me in the dish will betray Me. {24} "The Son of Man indeed goes just as it is written of Him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he had not been born."

(John 13) {23} Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved. {24} Simon Peter therefore motioned to him to ask who it was of whom He spoke. {25} Then, leaning back on Jesus' breast, he said to Him, "Lord, who is it?" {26} Jesus answered, "It is he to whom I shall give a piece of bread when I have dipped it." And having dipped the bread, He gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon.

(Matthew 26) {25} Then Judas, who was betraying Him, answered and said, "Rabbi, is it I?" He said to him, "You have said it."

(John 13) {27} Now after the piece of bread, Satan entered him. Then Jesus said to him, "What you do, do quickly." {28} But no one at the table knew for what reason He said this to him. {29} For some thought, because Judas had the money box, that Jesus had said to him, "Buy those things we need for the feast," or that he should give something to the poor. {30} Having received the piece of bread, he then went out immediately. And it was night. {31} So, when he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him. {32} "If God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and glorify Him immediately. {33} "Little children, I shall be with you a little while longer. You will seek Me; and as I said to the Jews, 'Where I am going, you cannot come,' so now I say to you.



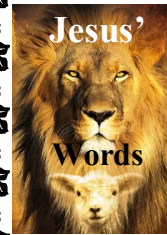

Core Christianity X: Demon Possession

There are three crucial attitudes to the demonic from our passage today:

1. The Scriptures are _____ for our understanding of the demonic, John 13:16-26

John 6:70 ... "Did I not choose you, the twelve, and one of you is a devil?"

Psalm 41:9 Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me.

Deuteronomy 29:29 "The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, ...

2 Peter 1:3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,

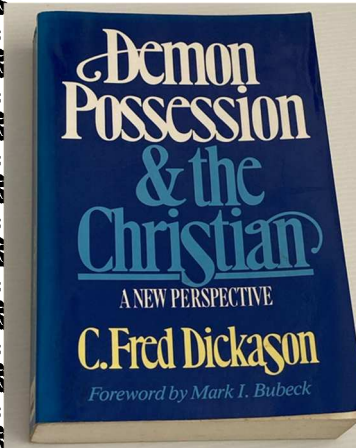
Matthew 26:22 And they were exceedingly sorrowful, and each of them began to say to Him, "Lord, is it I?"

Matthew 26:23-24 He answered and said, "He who dipped his hand with Me in the dish will betray Me. 24 The Son of Man indeed goes just as it is written of Him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he had not been born."

Matthew 26:25 Then Judas, who was betraying Him, answered and said, "Rabbi, is it I?" He said to him, "You have said it."

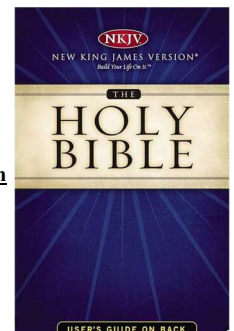
John 8:44 You are of your father the devil, ... he is a liar and the father of it.

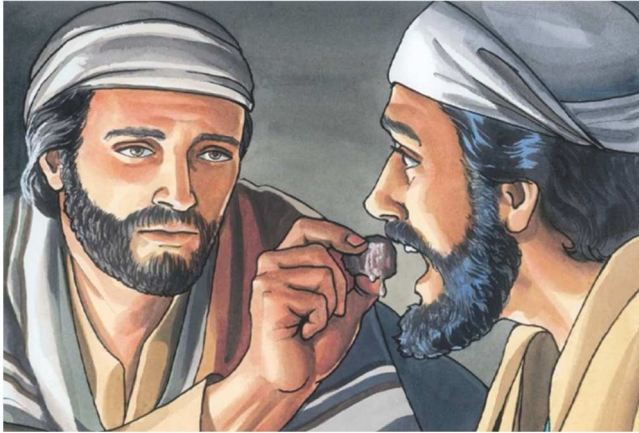

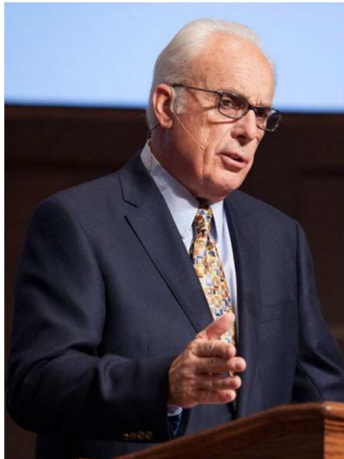
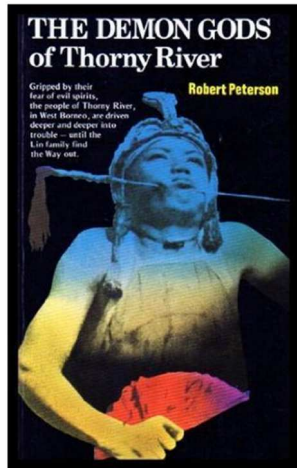
James 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

John 13:31-33

Acts 2:22-24 "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs ... Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death; 24 whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it.

Matthew 8:16 ... they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, ...

Luke 10:17 Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name."

Mark 16:17-18 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

Acts 16:18 ... But Paul, greatly annoyed, turned and said to the spirit, "I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her." And he came out that very hour.

Acts 19:13-16 Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves to call the name of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits, saying, "We exorcise you by the Jesus whom Paul preaches." 14 Also there were seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, who did so. 15 And the evil spirit answered and said, "Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you?" 16 Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

Revelation 2:9-10 "... I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. 10 ... Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, ...

Revelation 2:13 "I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan's throne is.

Revelation 3:9 ... those of the synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews and are not, but lie...



Matthew 12:27 And if I cast out demons by Beelzebul, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they shall be your judges.
