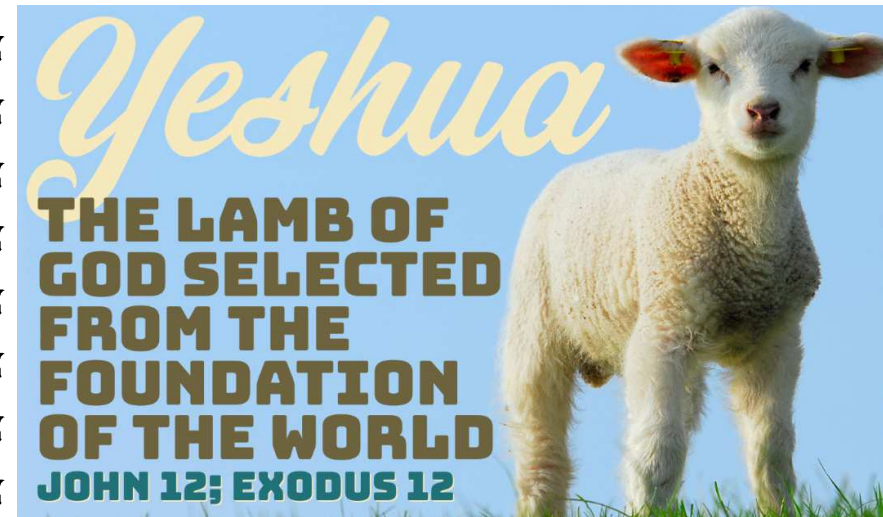

## The Thursday Before the Crucifixion (Evening)

*(Luke 22) {15} Then He said to them, "With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; {16} "for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." {17} Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and divide it among yourselves; {18} "for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes."*

*(Matthew 26) {26} And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, "Take, eat; this is My body." (Luke 22:19 which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me) {27} Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. (Luke 22:23 and they all drank from it) {28} "For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many (Luke 22:20 for you) for the remission of sins. {29} "But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."*

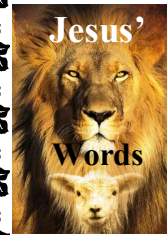

## Core Christianity XI: Pictures of the Saviour to Saviour

In Luke 22 and Matthew 26 there are 5 pictures of the Saviour to savour:

**1. How He \_\_\_\_\_ us: His \_\_\_\_\_ expressed, Luke**

22:15-16

**John 13:1** Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

**John 15:9** "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.

**John 15:13** Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

**Exodus 12:1-3** Now the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, 2 "This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you. 3 Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household.

**John 1:29** .... "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

**1 Corinthians 5:7** Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. ....

**1 Corinthians 11:28-29** But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. 29 For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

**Malachi 4:5** Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord.

**Luke 2:30-32** For my eyes have seen Your salvation 31 Which You have prepared before the face of all peoples, 32 A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people Israel."

**Romans 6:17** But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered.

**Galatians 5:1** Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.

**Exodus 6:6** Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I am the Lord; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

**1 Peter 2:9-10** But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

**Exodus 12:22** And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin. ...

**Genesis 15:13-14** ... "Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years. 14 And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; afterward they shall come out with great possessions.

**Isaiah 53:5** But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

**2 Corinthians 5:21** For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

**Exodus 13:8** And you shall tell your son in that day, saying, 'This is done because of what the Lord did for me when I came up from Egypt.'

**Psalms 114:1-4** When Israel went out of Egypt, The house of Jacob from a people of strange language, 2 Judah became His sanctuary, And Israel His dominion. 3 The sea saw it and fled; Jordan turned back. 4 The mountains skipped like rams, The little hills like lambs.

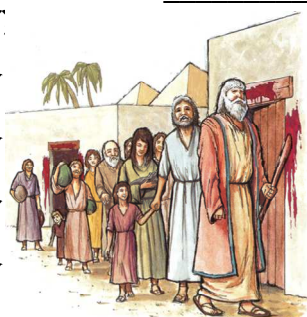
**Psalms 113:1-6** Praise the Lord! Praise, O servants of the Lord, Praise the name of the Lord! 2 Blessed be the name of the Lord From this time forth and forevermore! 3 From the rising of the sun to its going down The Lord's name is to be praised. 4 The Lord is high above all nations, His glory above the heavens. 5 Who is like the Lord our God, Who dwells on high, 6 Who humbles Himself to behold The things that are in the heavens and in the earth?

**Romans 6:19-23** ...For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, ..., so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness. 20 For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. ... 22 But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life. 23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

## 3. How He \_\_\_\_\_ to us and \_\_\_\_\_ us: His body \_\_\_\_\_, Matthew 26:26

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**Luke 22:19** And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."



**1 Corinthians 5:7** ... For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.

**1 Corinthians 15:3-4** For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

**1 Corinthians 11:23-24** For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."



## 4. How He \_\_\_\_\_ us and \_\_\_\_\_ us: His blood \_\_\_\_\_, Matthew 26:27-28

**Psalms 103:12** As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Genesis 15:9-10** ... "Bring Me a three-year-old heifer, a three-year-old female goat, a three-year-old ram, a turtledove, and a young pigeon." 10 Then he brought all these to Him and cut them in two, down the middle, and placed each piece opposite the other; ...

**Genesis 15:17** And it came to pass, when the sun went down and it was dark, that behold, there appeared a smoking oven and a burning torch that passed between those pieces.

**Genesis 15:18** On the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying: "To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates—

**Jeremiah 31:31** "Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—

**Jeremiah 31:33** ... I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

**Hebrews 9:11-15** But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, ... 12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. ... 15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, ...

**1 Corinthians 11:25-26** In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

**Exodus 6:6** ... I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

**1 Peter 1:18-19** knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

**Exodus 6:7** I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. ....

**Zechariah 12:10** "And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.

**Romans 11:26** And so all Israel will be saved, ...
