The Thursday Before the Crucifixion (Evening)

(John 13) {37} Peter said to Him, "Lord, why can I not follow You now? I will lay down my life for Your sake." (Luke 22:33 "Lord, I am ready to go with You, both to prison and to death.") {38} Jesus answered him, "Will you lay down your life for My sake? Most assuredly, I say to you, the rooster shall not crow (Luke 22:34 this day) till you have denied Me three times."

(Luke 22) {35} And He said to them, "When I sent you without money bag, knapsack, and sandals, did you lack anything?" So they said, "Nothing." {36} Then He said to them, "But now, he who has a money bag, let him take it, and likewise a knapsack; and he who has no sword, let him sell his garment and buy one. {37} "For I say to you that this which is written must still be accomplished in Me: 'And He was numbered with the transgressors.' For the things concerning Me have an end."

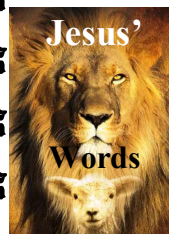

Since Jesus would be dead in less than 24 hours there would be some areas of life that the disciples would need to concentrate on. Today we consider the fourth:

Luke 22:35-38

Matthew 10:9-11 *"Provide neither gold nor silver nor copper in your money belts, sandals, nor staffs; for a worker is worthy of his food. (Mark 6:8 nothing for the journey except a staff; no bag, no bread, ..{9} but to wear sandals, and not to put on two tunics.)"*

Luke 10:4-5 *Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road. 5 But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.'*

Isaiah 53:12 *... He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.*

John 18:8-11 *Jesus answered, "I have told you that I am He. Therefore, if you seek Me, let these go their way," ... 10 Then Simon Peter, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus. 11 So Jesus said*

to Peter, "Put your sword into the sheath. Shall I not drink the cup which My Father has given Me?"

Acts 7:22-24 *And Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and deeds. 23 "Now when he was forty years old, it came into his heart to visit his brethren, the children of Israel. 24 And seeing one of them suffer wrong, he defended and avenged him who was oppressed, and struck down the Egyptian.*

Acts 7:30 *"And when forty years had passed, an Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire in a bush, in the wilderness of Mount Sinai.*



Acts 22:3 "I am indeed a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, taught according to the strictness of our fathers' law, and was zealous toward God as you all are today.

Galatians 1:15-21 But when it pleased God, who ... called me through His grace, 16 to reveal His Son in me, that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood, 17 nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me; but I went to Arabia, and returned again to Damascus. 18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and remained with him fifteen days.21 Afterward I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia.

Galatians 2:1 Then after fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and also took Titus with me.

Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." 1 Thessalonians 4:3 For this is the will of God, your sanctification: ...

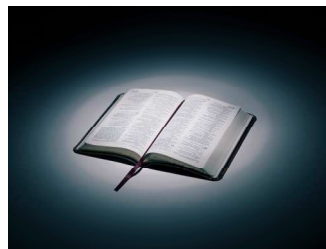

2 Corinthians 2:15-16 For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. 16 To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life. And who is sufficient for these things?

Mark 12:29-31 ... "The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. 30 And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. 31 And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."
