





Discipleship Series Guidance

(John 14:6) "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

(1 Peter 3:18) "For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God,....,"

(Isaiah 53:5) "But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; ..."

(1 Peter 2:24) "who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree,...."

(Romans 5:6) "For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly."

If we can answer 7 basic questions we should be able to find God's will:

1. Am I ______ **to** _____? John 15:4-8

(Romans 12:1-2) "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. {2} And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God."

(Romans 12:1-2) "Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. {2} Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and





perfect will." [paraphrase]

(Romans 12:1-2) And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will accept. When you think of what he has done for you, is this too much to ask? {2} Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will know what God wants you to do, and you will know how good and pleasing and perfect his will really is. [paraphrase]

2. What has God ______

(Psalms 119:105) "Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path."

(Psalms 19:8) "... The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;"

(Proverbs 6:23) "For the commandment is a lamp, And the law a light; Reproofs of instruction are the way of life,"

(2 Timothy 3:16-17) "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, {17} that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."

(2 Peter 1:19) "And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts;" (Philippians 2:3) "... in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself."

(Ephesians 5:22) "Wives, submit to your own husbands,"

(Ephesians 6:1) "Children, obey your parents in the Lord,"

(Ephesians 6:4) "And you, fathers, ... bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

(Ephesians 6:5) Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters ..."

(Colossians 4:1) "Masters, give your bondservants what is just and fair, ..."

(Psalms 101:3) "I will set nothing wicked before my eyes; .."

(Mark 10:19) ""You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' ..."" (Ephesians 5:18) "And do not be drunk with wine, ..."
