In Psalms 54 and 55 there are practical implications for us in two areas of the Christian life:

1. Spiritual ______, 54:1-7, 55:1-2, 16-18

(Ephesians 6:12) "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."



(1 Samuel 23:19) "Then the Ziphites came up to Saul at Gibeah, saying, "Is David not hiding with us in strongholds in the woods, in the hill of Hachilah, which is on the south of Jeshimon?"

(1 Samuel 26:1) "Now the Ziphites came to Saul at Gibeah, saying, "Is David not hiding in the hill of Hachilah, opposite Jeshimon?"" (Matthew 6:9) ""In this manner, therefore, pray: ..." (13) "And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one." (Ephesians 6:13) "Therefore take up the whole armor of

God, ..." (18) "praying always with all prayer and supplication in the

Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints;" (Ephesians 6:16) "above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one."

(Matthew 6:13) "And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen."

(Matthew 26:41) ""Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.""

(Philippians 4:13) "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

2. Personal______, 55:12-14,

1-7, 20-21, 9-11, 15, 23, 22

(2 Samuel 16:23) "Now the advice of Ahithophel, which he gave in those days, was as if one had inquired at the oracle of God." (Psalms 41:9) "Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me."



- (2 Samuel 11:3) "So David sent and inquired about the woman. And someone said, "Is this not Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?""
- (2 Samuel 23:34) "Eliphelet the son of Ahasbai.., Eliam the son of Ahithophel the Gilonite," (2 Samuel 15:12) "Then Absalom sent for Ahithophel the Gilonite, David's counselor, from his city; from Giloh; while he offered sacrifices. ..."
- (2 Samuel 15:31) "Then someone told David, saying, "Ahithophel is among the conspirators with Absalom." And David said, "O LORD, I pray, turn the counsel of Ahithophel into foolishness!"" (1 Peter 5:7) "casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you."
