# The Shepherds How to be Blessed by God

(Psalms 1:1) "Blessed is the man ..;"

(Psalms 1:1) "... Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly..."

2 Chronicles 17 gives four reasons why Jehoshaphat was blessed of God:

### **1. He Sought** \_\_\_\_\_\_, verses 1-3, 14-19

(Psalms 1:1) "... .. walks not in the counsel of the ungodly..."

(1 Corinthians 10:13) "No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is

faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it."

(Psalms 1:1) "Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, ..."

(Ephesians 2:10) "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."

(Ephesians 4:1) "... walk worthy of the calling with which you were called,"
