

Our Refuge

In Psalm 57 there are three well known but little used keys to finding the reality of a refuge in God:

1. ______, verses 0-2, 4, 6,



(Ephesians 6:12) "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."

(Proverbs 5:22) "His own iniquities entrap the wicked man, And he is caught in the cords of his sin."

2. _____, verses 1-3

(Psalms 17:8) "Keep me as the apple of Your eye; Hide me under the shadow of Your wings," (Psalms 36:7) "How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings."

(Psalms 63:7) "Because You have been my help, Therefore in the shadow of Your wings I will rejoice."

(Psalms 91:1) "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty."

(Psalms 62:7) "In God is my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, And my refuge, is in God."

(Psalms 91:2) "I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.""

(Psalms 91:9-10) "Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place, {10} No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;"

(Psalms 94:22) "But the LORD has been my defense, And my God the rock of my refuge."

(Psalms 142:5) "I cried out to You, O LORD: I said, "You are my refuge, My portion in the land of the living."

(Psalms 32:7) "You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of deliverance. Selah"

3. ______, verses 5, 7-11

(Psalms 108:1-5) "O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory. {2} Awake, lute and harp! I will awaken the dawn. {3} I will praise You, O LORD, among the peoples, And I will sing praises to You among the nations. {4} For Your mercy is great above the heavens, And Your truth reaches to the clouds. {5} Be exalted, O God, above the heavens, And Your glory above all the earth;"
