**1. A heart that** \_\_\_\_\_ **God,** verses 11, 9-10, 1-2

(Psalms 42:1-3) "As the deer pants for the water brooks, So pants my soul for You, O God. [2] My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?

[3] My tears have been my food day and night, ....""

(Psalms 42:7) "... All Your waves and billows have gone over me."

## 2. A heart that \_\_\_\_\_ God, verses 3,

7-8

(Psalm 63:3) Your unfailing love is better to me than life itself; ... [paraphrase]

(Ephesians 3:14) "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,"

(Ephesians 3:16-19) "that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, {17} that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, {18} may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height; {19} to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."

(Psalm 63:3-5). I will praise you. 4I will praise you as long as I live. I will lift up my hands in prayer to your name. 5 I will be content as if I had eaten the best foods. My lips will sing, and my mouth will praise you.

(Psalm 63:6) I lie awake thinking of you, meditating on you through the night.

(Psalms 63:8) My soul clings to you; ....
