fathers, 'The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you. {23} 'And it shall be that every soul who will not hear that Prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.' {25} "You are sons of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying to Abraham, 'And in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed.' {26} "To you first, God, having raised up His Servant Jesus, sent Him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from your iniquities."" (Hebrews 12:25) "See that you do not refuse Him who speaks. For if they did not escape who refused Him who spoke on earth, much more shall we not escape if we turn away from Him who

Finally, tears in her eyes, she reached out and took the paper that said LORD. Renewed in her commitment, she went back to her high school and began a witness that touched many lives for Christ.

Being filled with the Spirit involves a decision to say "Yes" to the Lord Jesus Christ. It means agreeing with Him when He points out something you are doing wrong, and taking action when He directs you. It means repenting when you slip and

experiencing His forgiveness (1 John 1:9).
