believe that Jesus is the Son of God.

Peter told believers they should always be ready to give a reason for their hope in Christ (1 Pet. 3:15). And in the book of Acts we read about the Spirit-empowered witness of Stephen and Paul (Acts 6:9-10; 24:24-25; 26:24-28).

What we say must be linked to a commitment to Jesus as Lord, and we must have a humble attitude, a clear conscience, and good conduct (1 Pet. 3:15-16). As we then rely on God, He can make people receptive to a discussion of why it makes sense to believe in Christ. A good life and good reasons make for a powerful witness.

"Must I go, and empty-handed," Thus my dear Redeemer meet? Not one day of service give Him, Lay no trophy at His feet?

Refrain:

"Must I go, and empty-handed?"
Must I meet my Saviour so?
Not one soul with which to greet Him,
Must I empty-handed go?

The strongest witness convinces the mind and convicts the heart.
