For Now--or Forever?

Receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. -- James 1:21

Cold terror gripped the heart of a soldier as mortar rounds whistled overhead, rifles cracked, and the Vietcong closed in. Suddenly he felt ripping pains as a bullet tore into his chest and arm. Yet it wasn't the end for this soldier. According to an article in the newspaper, the bullet was slowed by a New Testament he was carrying in his shirt pocket. Years later, the young man still treasured the blood-stained book with the ragged hole through the middle. He believes it saved his life.

This is a nice story, but it says nothing about the life-saving spiritual help the Bible was designed to give. In Ezekiel 33, we read that the ancient Israelites used the words of the prophets to make them feel good but not to

change their lives. They took passages out of context to support their confidence (v.24). They found pleasure in listening to the words of the prophet (v.30), yet the Lord said, "They hear your words, but they do not do them" (v.31). The result? They came under divine judgment.





Discipleship Series Grafting

(James 1:21-22)

- "Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness,
