Many people give their word, but we can't rely on what they say. After we get burned a few times, we begin to feel that we can't trust anybody.

David, who wrote Psalm 12, felt the same way. We don't know the specific situations that prompted his words, but he felt surrounded by untrustworthy people. He lamented, "Everyone lies" (v.2 NIV).

Everyone, that is, except God. His words are pure and flawless, like silver that has been through a refiner's fire seven times (v.6). We can believe God. His promises stand. He cannot lie. --DCE

Prayer

O Lord, even when it seems I can't trust anybody, I know I can trust You. I believe Your Word. Make my words as pure and trustworthy as Yours. Amen.
