(James 1:21) "Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls."

(1 Peter 3:15) "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;"

(1 Peter 2:21-24) "For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: [22] "Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth"; {23} who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously; [24] who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness; by whose stripes you were healed."

2. Messiah in His _____, Zechariah 9:9-10, 13:7

(Micah 5:4-5) "And He shall stand and feed His flock In the strength of the LORD. In the majesty of the name of the LORD His God; And they shall abide, For now He shall be great To the ends of the earth; {5} And this One shall be peace...."

(Malachi 3:1) ""Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming," Says the LORD of hosts."

(Matthew 19:28) "So Jesus said to them, "Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration, when the Son of Man sits on the throne of His glory, you who have followed Me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel."

(Matthew 24:30) ""Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory."


(Luke 9:43) "And they were all amazed at the majesty of God. ..."

(John 17:5) ""And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was."

(Hebrews 1:3) "who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, ... sat



down at the right hand of the Majesty on high," (1 Peter 4:13) "but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy." (2 Peter 1:16) "For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were evewitnesses of His majesty." (*Revelation 5:12*) "saying with a loud voice:

"Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!""

(2 Peter 3:18) "but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen."

Meat Meekness and Majesty



(2 Corinthians 3:18) "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord."

(1 John 3:2) "...when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is."

In the Old Testament prophecies of Christ's first coming there are two contrasting descriptions of Messiah:

1. Messiah in His _____, Zechariah 9:9, 13:7

(Micah 5:2) ""But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting.""

(Matthew 26:31) "Then Jesus said to them, "All of you will be made to stumble because of Me this night, for it is written: 'I will strike the Shepherd, And the sheep of the flock will be scattered.'" (Matthew 26:55-56) "In that hour Jesus said to the multitudes, "Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs to take Me? I sat daily with you, teaching in the temple, and you did not seize Me. [56] "But all this was done that the Scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled." Then all the disciples forsook Him and fled."

(Matthew 11:29) ""Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

(Luke 22:27) ""For who is greater, he who sits at the table, or he who serves? Is it not he who sits at the table? Yet I am among you as the One who serves."

(John 13:5) "After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded."

(2 Corinthians 8:9) "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, vet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich."

(Philippians 2:5-8) "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, {6} who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, {7} but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. [8] And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross."



(Matthew 5:5) "Blessed are the meek, For they shall inherit the earth." (2 Corinthians 10:1) "Now I, Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ; ..."

(Colossians 3:12-13) "Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; {13} bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do."
