Christ in the Psalms



(Luke 24:44) "... These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me."

Four facts about the Messiah come out of the Psalms:

1. He is the _____ of _____,
Psalm 2:1-4, 6-8

(Genesis 11:4) "And they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, ... lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth."

(Genesis 10:8-10) "Cush begot Nimrod; he began to be a mighty one on the earth. {9} He was a mighty hunter before the LORD; ...{10} And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, ... in the land of Shinar."

(Revelation 19:19) "And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army."


(Matthew 2:15) "and was there [in Egypt] until the death of Herod, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying, "Out of Egypt I called **My Son**."

(Acts 13:30-33) ""But God raised Him from the dead. {31} "He was seen for many days ..{32} "And we declare to you glad tidings; that promise which was made to the fathers. {33} "... in that He has raised up Jesus. As it is also written in the second Psalm: 'You are **My Son**, Today I have begotten You.'"

(Hebrews 1:5) "For to which of the angels did He ever say: "You are **My Son**, Today I have begotten You"? ...

(Hebrews 5:5) "So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but it was He who said to Him: "You are **My Son**, Today I have begotten You.'"

(Romans 1:3-4) "... His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, .. was ... {4} .. declared to be the **Son of God** with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead."



2. He is _____ and _____, Psalm 110: 1, 4

(Genesis 14:18-20) "Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High. {19} And he blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram ...; {20} And blessed be God Most High," And he gave him a tithe of all."

(2 Chronicles 26:17-20) "So Azariah the priest went in after him, and with him were eighty priests of the LORD; valiant men. {18} And they withstood King Uzziah, and said to him, "It is not for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to the LORD, but for the priests... you have trespassed! You shall have no honor from the LORD God." {19} Then Uzziah became furious; And while he was



angry with the priests, leprosy broke out on his forehead, {20} ... so they thrust him out of that place. Indeed he also hurried to get out, because the LORD had struck him."

(Hebrews 5:5-10) "So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but it was He who said to Him: "You are My Son, Today I have begotten You." {6} As He also says in another place: "You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek"; {7}... {8} though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered. {9} And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him, {10} called by God as High Priest "according to the order of Melchizedek,""

(Hebrews 6:19-20) "This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil, {20} where the forerunner has entered for us, even Jesus, having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek." (Hebrews 7:1-3) "For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him, {2} to whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all, first being translated "king of righteousness," and then also king of Salem, meaning "king of peace," {3} without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the Son of God, remains a priest continually."

(1 Corinthians 12:3) "... no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit."

3. His () and , Psalm 16:8-11

(Acts 2:23-32) ""Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death; {24} "whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it. {25} "For David says concerning Him: .. {26} ... {27} .. You will not leave my soul in Hades, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption. {28} ...' {29} "Men and brethren, let me speak freely to you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. {30} "Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, {31} "he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that His soul was not left in Hades, nor did His flesh see corruption. {32} "This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses."

(Acts 13:33-38) ""God has fulfilled this for us their children, in that He has raised up Jesus. As it is also written in the second Psalm: 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.' {34} "And that He raised Him from the dead, no more to return to corruption, He has spoken thus: ... {35} "... 'You will not allow Your Holy One to see corruption.' {36} "For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell asleep, was buried with his fathers, and saw corruption; {37} "but He whom God raised up saw no corruption. {38} "Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that through this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins;"

(John 6:54) ""Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day."

(Romans 10:9) "that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."



4. His _____, Psalm 110:1

(Acts 1:1-3) "The former account I made, ..., of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, {2} until the day in which He was taken up, ..., {3} ... He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God."

(Matthew 26:64) "... "It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven.""

(Mark 16:19) "So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God."

(Acts 2:34-35) ""For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, {35} Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.'""

(Romans 8:34) "Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us."

(Acts 7:55) "But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God,"

(Ephesians 1:5) "having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, ..., "

(1 Peter 2:9) "But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;"

(Romans 6:3-8) "Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? {4} Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. {5} For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, {6} ... {8} Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,"

(Colossians 3:2-4) "Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. {3} For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. {4} When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory."

(Luke 24:32-33) "..., "Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?"

{33} So they rose up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, ..., "
