Each has distinctive physical features—bushy eyebrows, stubby hands, a brawny build—the list goes on. And no two people have identical fingerprints. Truly every man, woman, and child is unique.

In Psalm 139, David praised his Creator and acknowledged that he was "fearfully and wonderfully made" (v.14) "and skilfully wrought" (v.15). So is each of us. Our Creator-God delights in our individuality. We don't have to envy others or feel inferior to them. Instead, we ought to express our uniqueness by serving God as only we can.

When we accept our place in the Creator's grand design, we see how good it is to be "one of a kind." –DJD

In Psalm 139:13-16 we want to highlight two areas of our lives where we can find personal contentment:


1. Who God has _____ me,
