so he could determine who fit the requirements. He was looking for help.

There is a huge difference between what that fast-food manager did and what we should do when we need help. We don't have to put out a <code>HelpWanted</code> sign.

According to our Bible reading for today, if we are followers of Jesus Christ we already have help within. We have the Spirit of God to give us assistance. He is ready, willing, and able to help us in our times of need. He even assists us when we try to tell God what we need and we're so confused that we don't even know what it is (Romans 8:26-27).

If help is wanted in your life today, inquire within--turn to the Holy Spirit. --KD

(John 15:19) ""If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of




