### **Apostles**

What characterised an apostle?

- 1. Their teaching was the foundation of the Church. (Eph 2.20; 3.5)
- 2. They were eyewitnesses of the resurrection. (Acts 1.21-26; 9.1-9; 1 Cor 15.7-8; cf 1 Cor 9.1)
- 3. They were personally chosen by Jesus Christ (Mt 10.1-4; Acts 1.26; Acts 9.15).
- 4. They were authenticated by miraculous signs.

- 6. Their place of honour is eternal. (Revelation 21:14)
