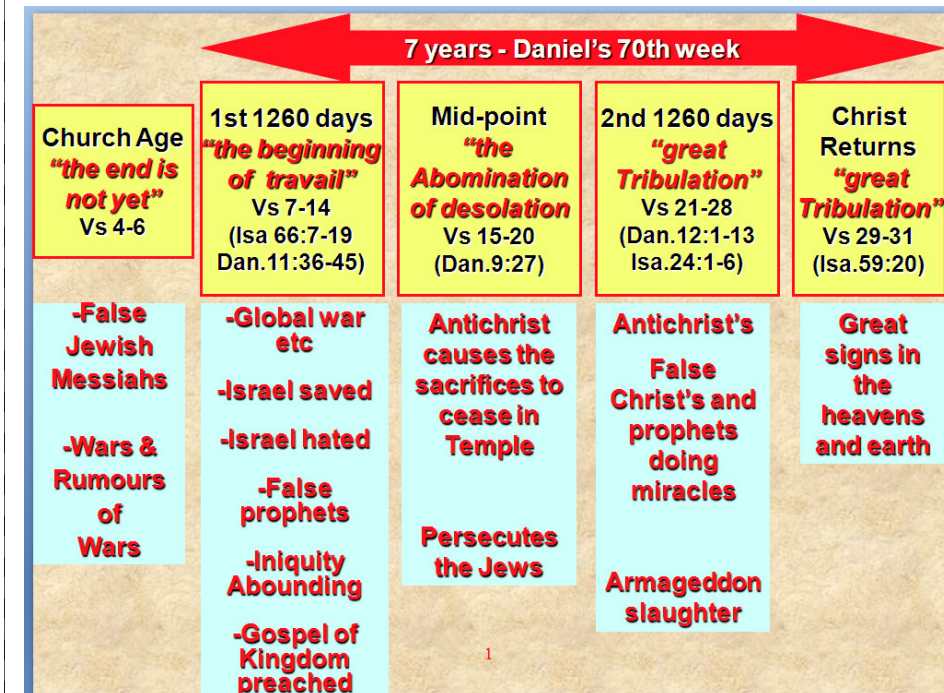

(Daniel 11:31) ""And forces shall be mustered by him, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and place there the abomination of desolation."

(Daniel 12:11-12) ""And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days. {12} "Blessed is he who waits, and comes to the one thousand three hundred and thirty-five days."

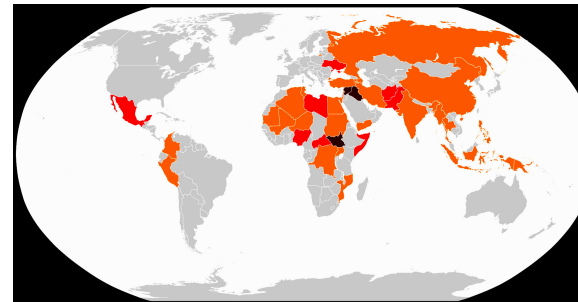

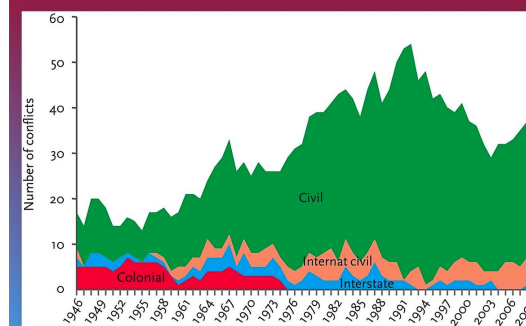


Locations^[1] of ongoing conflicts worldwide, November 2014

Number of Wars, 1946-2008

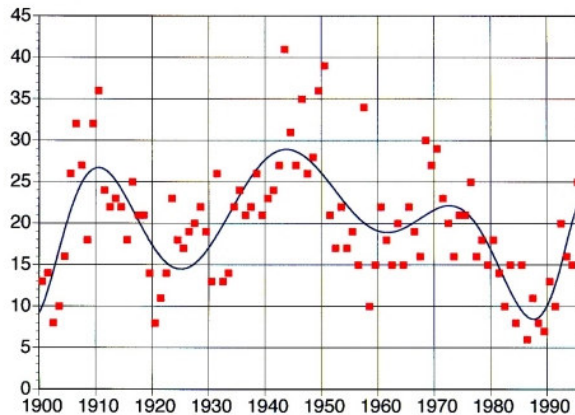

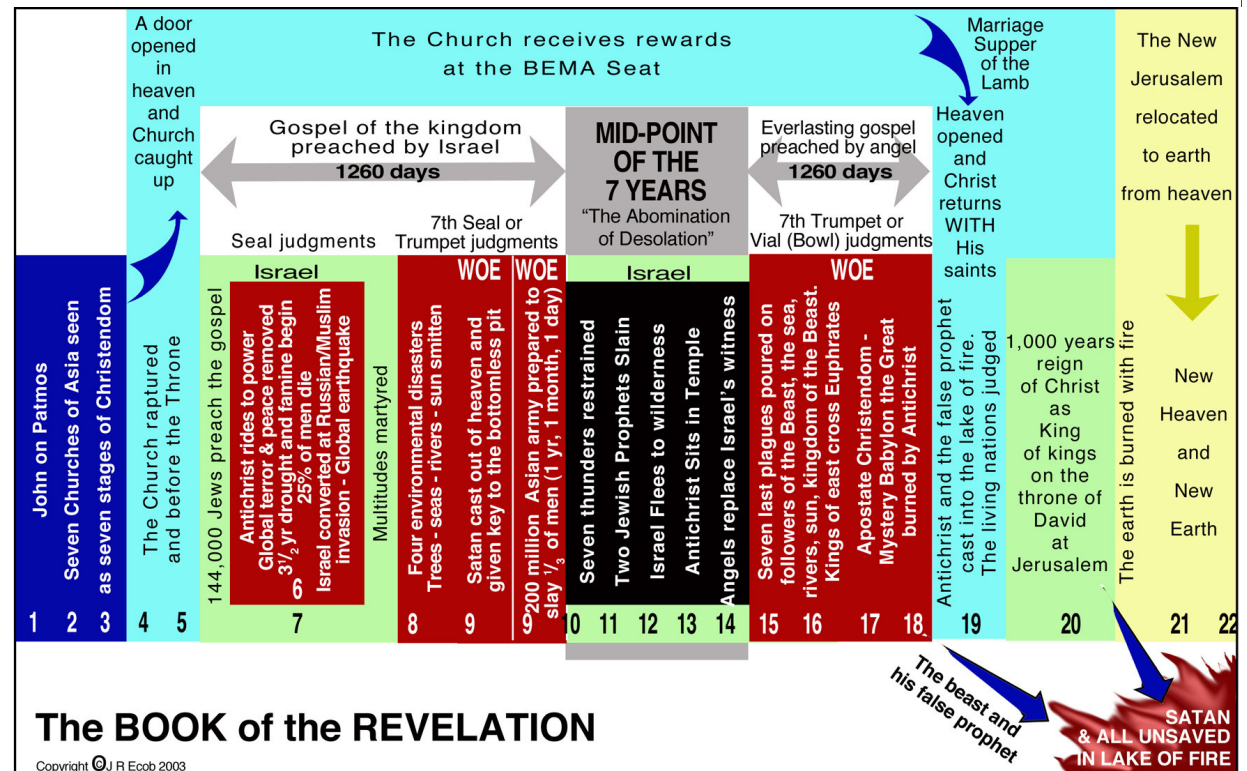
