

(Romans 11:26) "And so all Israel will be saved, ..;"

(Psalms 16:1-2) "Preserve me, O God, for in You I put my trust. {2} O my soul, you have said to the LORD, "You are my Lord, My goodness is nothing apart from You.""

(<u>Psalms 16:8-11</u>) "I have set the LORD always before me; Because He is at my right hand I shall not be moved. {9} Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope.
