

2 Kings 8:22

(2 Timothy 3:5) "having a form of godliness but denying its power..!"

(Philippians 3:10) "that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,"

(Acts 1:8) ""But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me ..""

(Genesis 9:6) ""Whoever sheds man's blood, By man his blood shall be shed; For in the image of God He made man."

(<u>Philippians 3:8-9</u>) "Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish,

that I may gain Christ {9} and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;"
