Jesus treated women with the utmost respect and honour (John 4:1-38; 8:3-11; 19:25-27). Likewise, in 1 Peter 3:7, husbands are instructed to live with their wives "with understanding, giving honour to the wife, as to the weaker vessel." Men and women both have their weaknesses, but the husband is treat his wife as if she were the weaker vessel. This in no way means they are inferior. In fact, Peter said that as Christians, men and women are "heirs together of the grace of life" (v.7).

Opening a door for a woman may seem to some like an old-fashioned courtesy. But it can also be a wonderful tribute to both the man and the woman if it symbolises the honour and respect one has for the other.
