First, my friend Rafael and I talked to Jimmy, a mechanic from Liverpool, on "the tube". Jimmy had asked where to board the tube to Euston. He needed help with his luggage, and we were headed that way. *Pow!* Divine appointment.

Two days later, Lisa, the young woman above, surprised us with her question. *Pow!* Divine appointment.

Then, getting off the plane after coming home, Rick, a young soldier, asked how to get to the city bus station, only to find that the last bus to his base had just left. *Pow!* Divine appointment.

How did I know these were divine appointments? I didn't have Philip's supernatural guidance (Acts 8). But God seemed to be opening doors to walk through. So what happened?

Jimmy had been hurt by some things that had happened at church (and trust me, they were bad). We directed him to learn about Jesus Christ through the Bible. He went from "I never want to have anything to do with it again" to "Maybe I'll read my Bible."

Lisa needed salvation. She had 'accepted' Christ when younger, but her sin during the uni years had led her to wonder whether God would have her now.

And Rick? Well, he trusted Christ to be his Saviour on the way to the bus station. Pray for him. He is a great bloke, and he's starting a wonderful adventure.

And me? Maybe my eyes opened a little wider, or my ears cleared out a little, so I could sense divine appointments. --JC


