further."



Our unknown future is secure in the hands of our all-knowing God.





Insights for Living Learning from the Church at



Philippi

We can learn some lessons from the characters involved in planting the church at Philippi:

1. Have an _____ heart, Acts 16:11-15

(Revelation 3:20) ""Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me."

(2 Corinthians 3:16) "Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away."

(Acts 26:18) "'to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'"



2. Beware the _______, Acts 16:16-18

(Matthew 12:43-45) ""When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. {44} "Then he says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when he comes, he finds it empty, swept, and put in order. {45} "Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first. ...""

(Leviticus 19:26) "You shall not eat anything with the blood, nor shall you practice divination or soothsaying."



For he is a liar and the father of lies.

(Leviticus 20:6) "And the person who turns to mediums and familiar spirits [spiritists], to prostitute himself with them, I will set My face against that person and cut him off from his people."

3. Expect ______, Acts 16:19-24

(John 3:19) "".. men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil."

(2 Corinthians 2:15-16) "For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. {16} To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life. And who is sufficient for these things?"

(1 Corinthians 16:13-14) "Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong. {14} Let all that you do be done with love.' (Matthew 10:24-26) ""A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master. {25} "It is enough for a disciple that he be like his teacher, and a servant like his



master. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more will they call those of his household! [26] "Therefore do not fear them. ..."

(John 15:20) ""Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also."

4. Be ______, Acts 17:14-15, 18:1, 5, 19:22


(1 Timothy 6:8) "And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content."
