

Essentials

Jesus words surrounding Matthew's call highlight 3 essentials for fervent Christian living:

1. B , Mark 2:14-17

K (Matthew 9:13) ""But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.' ...""

(Galatians 5:17) "For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish."

(John 15:5) "".. without Me you can do nothing."
