and I could not see ourselves signing the death warrants of innocent victims, we must still guard against hard-heartedness and pray for a spirit that is the very opposite of Stalin's depraved sadism. We must plead for divine enablement to fulfil Paul's imperative: "Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamour, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you" (Eph. 4:31-32).

Ask Jesus to help you replace any lingering hard-heartedness in your life with His tenderheartedness. And show Christlike compassion to someone today. --VCG


