In Jesus' day, the scribes and Pharisees were hypocrites who concentrated on the appearance of holiness while neglecting heart-holiness (Mt. 23:25). When the light of Jesus shone on them, He revealed the truth about their outwardly religious life. He didn't say these external acts were necessarily wrong, but they were wrongfully used as a cover up for wickedness. For them, inner house cleaning was long overdue.

Keeping up appearances in our housework isn't serious, but pretending our hearts are clean is. Only those who are clean on the inside will welcome Jesus with confidence when He returns. Is your heart ready, or is inner house cleaning needed? Now is the time to take care of it! --JEY


Purifying the Church
