Dangerous Chase

Jamie Engelking was playing a game of chase down the slope. He was ripping though the gates at a rapid rate for aa eight year old.

A young friend following him was doing her best to keep up. This game of "chase" was innocent and fun. It was two kids trying to improve their downhill skiing.

Then tragedy struck.

As Jamie cut too close to a gate, he hit a pole, pulling it out of the ground and causing its sharp base to point up in the air. The young girl chasing him never saw it coming. It pierced her eye and killed her instantly.

Jamie is now a highly rated Alpine skier. He can slalom downhill with the best of them. His team has named him captain. But he still carries the pain of being involved in a young girl's death. Life often resembles a chase. Much like Jamie and a young friend racing down a hill, you may find yourself running hard these days to get good marks, make great friends, and achieve success. People are leading you . . . friends, loved ones, peers. But who are these people you are chasing? Where are they going? Does the path include dangers like alcohol or drugs?

Jesus Christ gave us wise words to consider when He said, "If a blind man leads a blind man, both will fall into a pit" (Matthew 15:14). The people leading you may be caught up in a chase that seems innocent enough but leads to a tragic conclusion. Ask Jesus to help you make sure that the people you are following are ultimately leading you into a deeper relationship with Him. -TF REFLECTION

- Who are the people leading me? Where are we going?
- How are my relationships helping or hindering my walk with Christ?
- What about those who are following my lead? Am I taking them on a course that will help them?


