condemnation? {41} "And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong." {42} Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom." {43} And Jesus said to him, <u>"Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with</u> <u>Me in Paradise."</u>

(John 19) {25} Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. {26} When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple whom He loved standing by, He said to His mother, <u>"Woman, behold your son!"</u> {27} Then He said to the disciple, <u>"Behold your mother!"</u> And from that hour that disciple took her to his own home.

(<u>Romans 5:8)</u> But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

(1 John 4:9-10) In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. (10) In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propriation for our sins.

(John 3:16) For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
