

## (Luke 24) {7} "saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.'" {8} And they remembered His words.

(Matthew 28) {7} "And go quickly and tell His disciples (Mark 16:7 and Peter) that He is risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee (Mark 16:7 as He said to you); there you will see Him. Behold, I have told you." {8} So they went out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy (Mark 16:7 for they trembled and were amazed And they said nothing to anyone,), and ran to bring His disciples word.

(john 20) {11}... Mary stood outside by the tomb weeping, and as she wept she stooped down and looked into the tomb. {12} And she saw two angels in white sitting, one at the head and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain. {13} Then they said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him." {14} Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, and did not know that it was Jesus. {15} Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, "Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away." {16} Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which is to say, Teacher). {17} Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, "I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God."" {18} Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and that He had spoken these things to her.

(Mark 16) {11} And when they heard that He was alive and had been seen by her, they did not believe.





## Resurrection Report

(Selected)

Please note how the three eyewitnesses (Matthew, Mark ,and John) mesh with the each other and the historian (Luke) to produce one clear report of the resurrection events:

(Mark 16) Now when the Sabbath was past, (John 20:1 while it was still dark) (Matthew 28:1 as the first day of the week began to dawn) Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, that they might come and anoint Him

(Mark 16) {3} And they said among themselves, "Who will roll away the stone from the door of the tomb for us?" {4} But when they looked up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away; for it was very large.

(Luke 24) {3} Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.

[(John 20) {2} Then Mary ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him." ]

(luke 24) {4} And it happened, as the women were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments. (Mark 16:5 a young man clothed in a long white robe sit-



ting on the right side) {5} Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth,

(Mark 16) {6} But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him. (Luke 24:5 "Why do you seek the living among the dead? {6} .. Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee)



## Does the Resurrection Convince You?

From Luke 16:19-31 we gain 4 important insights

**1. We all can** the way to \_\_\_\_\_, verses 19-21 (Matthew 7:13-14) "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. (14) Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

**2. We all will**, verse 22 (<u>Hebrews 9:27</u>) And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,

**3. We will all be**, verses 22-23 (*Revelation 20:11-15*) Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose  $\phi' \phi'$  face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. (12) And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. (Revelation 20:14) Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

(Acts 1:3) ... He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

(1 Corinthians 15:3-8) For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, (4) and that He was buried, and that He  $\mathcal{N}$  rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, (5) and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. (6) After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of With whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. (7) After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. (8) Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

(1 Corinthians 15:22) For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.
