2. His _____, verses 7-9

Revelation 20:10 — 10 The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone .. And ... will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Luke 19:27 — 27 But bring here those enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, and slay them before me.’”
