Matthew 6:5 "And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward."

#4. W _____, verse 15

Mark 7:36 Then He commanded them that they should tell no one; but the more He commanded them, the more widely they proclaimed it.

Matthew 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

#5. P _____, verses 16-22

Matthew 5:33-37 "Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform your oaths to the Lord.' 34 But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God's throne; ... 37 But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one."

John 8:42-44 ... "If God were your Father, you would love Me, ... 44 You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it."

Ephesians 4:15 ... speaking the truth in love,



Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.



Crucial Concerns VII

Galatians 5:17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

On the Tuesday before His death Jesus gave his last public sermon, recorded in Matthew 23 and parallel verses. His strong words in that passage describe three ways we must change (today the last one):

1. We must adjust our attitude,
2. We must change our behaviour, [last time]

3. We must _____ our heart, 23:13-39

John 11:53 Then, from that day on, they plotted to put Him to death

This applies to eight areas of the Christian life:

#1. S _____, verse 13

2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you are disqualified.

Hebrews 4:1 Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it.

1 Corinthians 9:24 Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it.

Romans 8:9 Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.

#2. G _____, verse 14

John 10:11-13 "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep. 12 But a hireling, he who is not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; 13 The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep."

Ezekiel 34:2 "... "Woe to the shepherds of Israel who feed themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flocks?"

2 Peter 2:3 By covetousness they will exploit you with deceptive words; for a long time their judgment has not been idle, and their destruction does not slumber. **Matthew 6:24** "No one can serve two masters; You cannot serve God and mammon."
