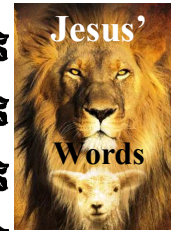


The Tuesday Before the Crucifixion X

(Matthew 24) "Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. (Mark 13:1 "Teacher, see what manner of stones and what buildings are here!" ; Luke 21:5 beautiful stones and donations)
 {2} And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down."
 {3} Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples (Mark 13:3 Peter, James, John, and Andrew) came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? (Luke 21:7 And what sign will there be when these things are about to take place?)" And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"
 {4} And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you.
 {5} "For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many. (Luke 21:8 and, [say] 'The time has drawn near.' Therefore do not go after them.)
 {6} "And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.
 {7} "For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. (Luke 21:11 and there will be fearful sights and great signs from heaven.)
 {8} "All these are the beginning of sorrows.
 {9} (Mark 13:9 "But watch out for yourselves,) "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, (Mark 13:9 for they will deliver you up to councils, and you will be beaten in the synagogues; Luke 21:12 they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons) (Mark 13:9 You will be brought before rulers and kings for My sake, for a testimony to them) and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake.
 {10} "And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another.
 {11} "Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.
 {12} "And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.
 {13} "But he who endures to the end shall be saved.
 {14} "And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Luke 21:13 it will turn out for you as an occasion for testimony.)

Tuesday Crucial Concerns X

On the Tuesday before His death, as Jesus leaves the temple, Jesus' disciples ask 4 questions. This results in Jesus longest answer recorded anywhere in the gospels (Matthew 24-25).

Titus 2:13 looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,
Luke 19:11 ... they thought the kingdom of God would appear immediately.
2 Peter 3:4 ... saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? ..."
Hebrews 9:28 ... To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.



There are two aspects of Christ's answer for us to consider today:

Luke 21:20 "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near.

Luke 21:21–24 Then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains, let those who are in the midst of her depart, and let not those who are in the country enter her. 22 For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. 23 But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people. 24 And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

John 14:1–3 “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

Hebrews 10:26–27 For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, 27 but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries.

Hebrews 2:3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him,

Revelation 6:15–17 And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains, 16 and said to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! 17 For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?”

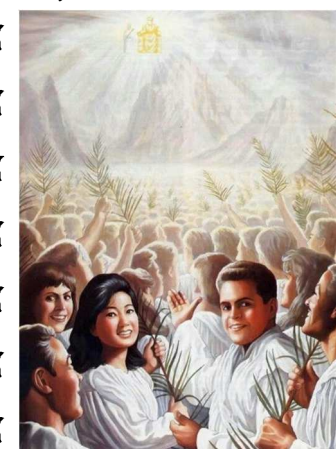

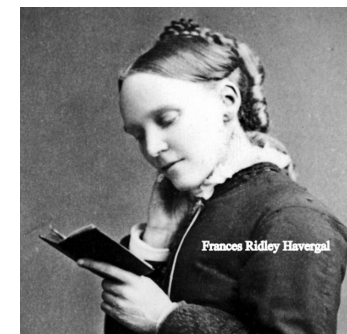
1 Thessalonians 5:9 For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,

1 Thessalonians 4:13–18 But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. 14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. 15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. 16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.



Revelation 7:9–10 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, 10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!”

Revelation 7:14 .. “These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.



1 Corinthians 1:7 .. eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Philippians 3:20–21 For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, 21 who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

2 Timothy 4:8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.
