<u>Matthew 22:43</u> He said to them, "How then does **David in the Spirit** call Him 'Lord,' saying: 1 Corinthians 15:25 For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet.



<u>Matthew 22:44–45</u> 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool" '? 45 If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?"

Luke 1:32 He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a Child is born,

Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. ...



<u>Psalm 2:9</u> You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel.'"

Psalm 132:13 For the Lord has chosen Zion; ....

Revelation 19:11–16 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. ... 14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS

<u>I Corinthians 10:13</u> No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

<u>Ephesians 6:13–14</u> Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, ...

<u>2 Chronicles 26:16</u> But when he was strong his heart was lifted up, to his destruction, for he transgressed against the Lord his God by entering the temple of the Lord to burn incense on the altar of incense....19 ... And while he was angry with the priests, leprosy broke out on his forehead,

<u>Hebrews 7:1</u> For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God, who met Abraham ... and blessed him,

<u>Hebrews 2:17</u> Therefore, in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

<u>Hebrews 2:18</u> For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.

<u>Hebrews 4:14</u> Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

His prayers for us, stream out like the light of the sunrise Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throng of grace, that we

boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.

Hebrews 7:24–25 But He, because He

continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. 25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

<u>Hebrews 7:26</u> For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens;

<u>Hebrews 8:1</u> Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens,

<u>Hebrews 10:19–25</u> Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh,



21 and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, 25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Acts 7:55–56 But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God, 56 and said, "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!"
